Siskiyou County Clerk Colleen Setzer announces that the Siskiyou County Clerk's Office is currently recruiting poll workers for the June 5, 2018 Statewide Primary Election. Positions are available at all polling locations throughout the county, including positions for bilingual poll workers.

Poll workers are the backbone of the election process as they are responsible for insuring election procedures are followed at the polling places. Duties include setting up the voting location, processing voters and closing out the site at the end of the day. Poll workers work an average of 16 hours on Election Day and receive a stipend for their work. Comprehensive poll worker training classes will be held on May 16<sup>th</sup> in Yreka and May 17<sup>th</sup> in Mt. Shasta.
