

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Siskiyou County Board of Supervisors will hold a Public Hearing on Tuesday, July 3, 2018, at 10:30a.m., in the Board of Supervisors' Chambers, Siskiyou County Courthouse, 311 Fourth Street, Yreka, California on the following item:

COUNTY JAIL PROJECT AND SUBSEQUENT MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION

The project is located at 269 Sharps Road in the City of Yreka, California. The site is on the south side of Sharps Road and is east of Interstate 5 in Siskiyou County, California, on APN 062-141-140, Portion of Section 34, T45N, R7W, Mount Diablo Base & Meridian (Latitude 41.423009°N, Longitude 122.380458°W). The project consists of the construction of a Type II Adult Detention Facility including a new facility and improvements to the existing Charlie Byrd Youth Correction Center (CBYCC) facility. This project is smaller than the previously approved project to construct a similar facility at a different site. The CBYCC would be upgraded and used for special inmate populations, intake, visitation, laundry, kitchen, and staff and administration areas. The new facility would contain a total of 160 beds and would be located on an 84-acre parcel that also includes the County Fairgrounds.

Based on the Subsequent Initial Study prepared for the project pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), a Subsequent Mitigated Negative Declaration (SCH No. 2013102016) was prepared to analyze potential impacts and staff is recommending to the Board that it be adopted with a Mitigation Monitoring Report Program. A Mitigated Negative Declaration is a statement that the project would not have a significant adverse effect on the environment because mitigation measures have been incorporated into the project to reduce potential impacts to a less-than-significant level. 
The Board of Supervisors will consider the proposed Subsequent Mitigated Negative Declaration pursuant to Section 15074 of the State Guidelines for Implementation of CEQA based on the record of evidence before them.

It is advised that the presenter bring 7 copies of anything presented to the Board and that the presenter create copies in advance for their own records.

If you challenge the proposed Mitigated Negative Declaration and/or above described project in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to Planning prior to or at the public hearing.
