

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING FOR APPLICATION SUBMITTAL**


NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Siskiyou County Board of Supervisors will conduct a public hearing on December 5, 2017 at 10:30 AM at the Board Chambers, 311 Fourth Street, Yreka, to consider funding Code Enforcement in Siskiyou County's low/mod service areas from Siskiyou County's Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program Income.
