All items presented to the Hearing Board during a public hearing become a permanent part of the record. Twelve copies of any information presented to the Hearing Board should be given to the Clerk of the Hearing Board for distribution to the Board Members. In order to obtain an accurate record of the testimony, please address the Hearing Board at the speaking table and clearly introduce yourself with your full name and address. Your address will not be included in the minutes of the hearing. The Chair of the Hearing Board may impose reasonable time limits upon statements and presentations.

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**6. PUBLIC HEARING PROTOCOL**

The public is encouraged to participate in the hearing process. The Chair of the Hearing Board will conduct the public hearing through the following actions:

- A. The Chair introduces the hearing item.
- B. The Chair opens the public hearing.
- C. A representative of the issuing Department shall summarize the accounting costs incurred in the enforcement case which gave rise to the costs and the contents of the Enforcement Officer's cost accounting case file shall be admitted as prima facie evidence of the facts stated therein.
- D. Any other written evidence not already provided to the Hearing Board is acknowledged and made a part of the record. County staff shall summarize the contents of this evidence.
- E. The Chair will ask if any of the Hearing Board Members have questions of staff.
- F. The Responsible Party is given an opportunity to present their arguments and evidence.
- G. The Public is given the opportunity to provide public comment.
- H. The Responsible Party is given an opportunity to present a rebuttal.
- I. After all testimony has been given, the Chair will close the public hearing and the Hearing Board will discuss the matter. During this discussion, the Hearing Board may elect to reopen the hearing to individually ask questions of the Responsible Party, proponent, opponent any other public member, or staff at the convenience of the Hearing Board.
- J. The Chair will entertain a motion and a second.
- K. The Hearing Board will discuss the question.
- L. The Hearing Board will render its decision.

**7. DECISION OF THE ACCOUNTING HEARING BOARD**

The ruling of the Hearing Board will be a recommendation that shall be in the form of a written resolution recommending the Board of Supervisors confirm, discharge, or modify the proposed special assessment and/or proposed lien against the property.

The written recommendation of the Hearing Board shall be considered by the Board of Supervisors at the Board's next available meeting following issuance of the recommendation.

The Board of Supervisors may adopt the recommendation without further notice of hearing, or may set the matter for a de novo hearing before the Board. If the Board adopts the recommendation, the Board's ruling is a final administrative order.
