Siskiyou County Burn Guide Lines

Permits: District permits are required year around for all burning except for a residential pile no larger than four (4) feet in diameter. Project burns larger than 10 acres, excluding crop land burns, require a Smoke Management Plan on file with the Air Pollution Control District before a permit can be issued.

Permit Dates: May 1st to the end of fire season from CALFIRE or USFS
End of fire season to May 1st from the Air Pollution Control District

Burning Hours:

Outside of Fire Season:

Burn days: 08:00 to 18:00 (8 am to 6 pm)

Marginal days: 10:00 to 15:00 (10 am to 3 pm)

No Burn days: No burning allowed, including residential burning

Fire Season:

Burn days: 08:00 to 18:00 (8 am to 6 pm)

Marginal days: 06:00 to 12:00 (6 am to 12 pm)

No Burn days: No burning allowed, including residential burning

Allowable combustibles: Non-treated clean wood waste
Clean, dry vegetation that originated on the premises
