Dear Congressman Herger:

It has recently come to our understanding that you have requested our opinion with respect to an amendment that may be offered in Congress to eliminate any funding for the study of dam removal on the Klamath River.

Our understanding is that the amendment would seek to prohibit the use of funds to implement or study dam removal or conduct sedimentation studies.

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Siskiyou has reviewed your request and voted in favor of sending you this letter in support of an amendment to the legislation which would prohibit the use of any funds for study of dam removal on the Klamath River, including sedimentation studies or other studies to be utilized to implement such activities.

The Board of Supervisors would also be supportive of any limiting amendments for funding for the Klamath Basin Restoration Agreement (KBRA) or the Klamath Hydroelectric Settlement Agreement (KHSA) and would support an amendment to prohibit the use of any funds for these activities.
