

Used motor oil never wears out, it just gets dirty!

Oil can be recycled, cleaned, and used again. Recycling used motor oil conserves a natural resource and is good for the environment.

Motor oil poured onto the ground or into storm drains, or tossed into trash cans (even in a sealed container) can contaminate and pollute the soil, groundwater, streams, and rivers, and it's illegal!

- One gallon of used oil can contaminate up to one million gallons of water.
- One gallon of used oil produces the same amount of motor oil as 42 gallons of crude oil.
- Oil dumped on the ground can seep underground into the water supply and reduces soil productivity.
- The oil we use today is different from the oil used by our parents and grandparents. Today's oil has more additives that enhance performance but also make the oil more toxic when improperly disposed.
- If the oil generated by all DIY oil changers in America were collected and re-refined, it would provide enough motor oil for 8 million cars each year.
- Recycling 1 ton of used oil filters recovers up to 1,700 pounds of steel and up to 60 gallons of oil.
- Re-refined oil is both environmentally-friendly and more cost-effective.

Call for a collection center


When you take your used oil to a collection center for recycling, you are protecting the environment and conserving a valuable resource.

Used oil that is brought in for recycling is transported to a recycling facility where it is re-refined into new products such as motor oil, fuel, and more.

Re-refining takes about one-third the energy of refining crude oil. Also, it only takes one gallon of used oil to produce the same amount of motor oil as 42 gallons of crude oil.

Using recycled oil for these products creates jobs, reduces the depletion of natural resources, and reduces our dependence on foreign oil sources.

Used motor oil is collected for **free** at many locations in Siskiyou County. After draining the oil from your vehicle, follow these steps.

DO put it in a clean, leakproof container with a tight lid and a spout for pouring.

DO call ahead for hours and to make certain that the site nearest you can accept your quantity of oil.

DO NOT mix your oil with anything else. To be recycled, your oil must **not** have any contaminants like water, paint, gasoline, bleach, or chlorinated solvents like brake cleaner.
