NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT A MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION FOR THE SISKIYOU COUNTY JAIL

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Siskiyou County Planning invites public review and comment on the environmental documents prepared for the Siskiyou County Jail. The public review period begins on May 21, 2018, and ends on June 18, 2018. The Initial Study and all attachments are available for review on the County of Siskiyou's website at www.co.siskiyou.ca.us in the Planning Division's public documents section found at: www.co.siskiyou.ca.us/page/planning-division. Written comments concerning the project and the environmental documents will be accepted until 5:00 P.M. on June 18, 2018, at Siskiyou County Community Development - Planning Division, 806 South Main Street, Yreka, California, 96097. The documents are posted in the County Clerk's Office and are also available at Siskiyou County Community Development Department.

Project Location and Description: The project is located at 269 Sharps Road in the City of Yreka, California. The site is on the south side of Sharps Road and is east of Interstate 5 in Siskiyou County, California, on APN 062-141-140, Portion of Section 34, T45N, R7W, Mount Diablo Base & Meridian (Latitude 41.423009°N, Longitude 122.380458°W). The project consists of the construction of a Type II Adult Detention Facility including a new facility and improvements to the existing Charlie Byrd Youth Correction Center (CBYCC) facility. This project is smaller than the previously approved project to construct a similar facility at a different site. The CBYCC would be upgraded and used for special inmate populations, intake, visitation, laundry, kitchen, and staff and administration areas. The new facility would contain a total of 160 beds and would be located on an 84-acre parcel that also includes the County Fairgrounds.
