## NOTICE OF INTENT/NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING TO ADOPT A CONDITIONAL WAIVER OF WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR

## SMALL FOOD PROCESSORS AND RELATED AGRICULTURAL PROCESSORS WITHIN THE CENTRAL VALLEY REGION

Water Code section 13269 authorizes the Central Valley Reginal Water Quality Control Board (Central Valley Water Board) to conditionally waive waste discharge requirements if the waiver is consistent with the Central Valley Water Board's water quality control plan and is in the public interest. The Central Valley Water Board is proposing to adopt a Conditional Waiver to regulate the discharge of wastewater and residual solids from small food processing operations and certain agricultural operations (such as nut hulling and seed washing operations). The proposed Conditional Waiver will renew the previous Waiver (Order R5-2020-0002) which allowed discharges of up to 1,000,000 gallons of process wastewater per year to irrigate crops or landscaped areas and the use of the associated residual solids as a soil amendment on cropped or landscaped areas provided that the characteristics of the discharge meet the criteria specified in the Waiver.

The Central Valley Water Board's adoption of the Conditional Waiver is considered a project under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA). The Central Valley Water Board is the lead agency for the project. There are no substantial changes proposed in the project or the circumstances under which the "project" will be undertaken, that will require revisions of the previously adopted Initial Study and Mitigated Negative Declaration that evaluated the prior conditional waiver. The adoption of this resolution is exempt from CEQA insofar as it continues to provide regulatory coverage, in the form of a conditional waiver per Water Code section 13269, for existing facilities and operations; there are no substantial expansions in operations authorized under this resolution and waiver.
