October 9, 2019 - The County of Siskiyou in rural Northern California won the Pinnacle and Members' Choice Awards for County Small Population Group for their website redesign from the National Association of Government Web Professionals (NAGW). This award recognizes the work done by the web design team from Siskiyou and the team at Municode, who handled the technical aspects of the project and ongoing support.

Siskiyou's last web redesign was four years ago. In the time since, web standards and audiences had drastically changed. Finding relevant information took too many clicks for residents. In addition, the site needed a modern look, had to be ADA accessible and mobile responsive. The web redesign effort was led by Judy Crawford who is the webmaster and a member of the IT support staff provided to the County by Avenu Insights & Analytics. Judy says, "The new website has received positive input from county residents and other municipalities" and that she enjoys making ongoing improvements and enhancements."

After viewing Municode's wide array of clients, their web designers showed they were capable of Siskiyou's web redesign. Siskiyou utilized a team of 10 employees from across County Departments. Both the County and Municode worked seamlessly together, which Judy Crawford credits to Municode's "Willingness to interact, responsiveness price and continued support."

The website went live in February 2019. The Pinnacle and Members' Choice Awards were announced at the annual NAGW conference in Salt Lake City, Utah this past September.
