

**“Klamath River Recycling”
Scope of Work**

1. Collection, separation, and transportation of recyclable beverage containers collected from “Siskiyou Recycles” at the following four (4) locations to a CalRecycle Certified Recycling Center:

2. Recyclable materials include those beverage containers eligible for California Refund Value (CRV) including:
 - a. #1 Plastic containers
 - b. #2 Plastic containers
 - c. Clear Glass containers
 - d. Green Glass containers
 - e. Brown Glass containers
 - f. Aluminum cans
3. Contractor shall provide the necessary equipment to collect recyclables including, but not limited to, one padlock per recycling bin and any vehicles necessary for the transportation of recyclables.
4. Contractor shall collect materials and transport them to a recycling center a minimum of once a week.
5. Contractor shall provide pickup schedule to the County.
6. Contractor shall pick up litter around bins and dispose of at their own cost.
7. Contractor shall do all necessary paperwork and reporting regarding the collection of the recyclables in accordance with CalRecycle rules and regulations.
8. Contractor shall retain the California Refund Value (CRV) and scrap value for all material collected at the sites and provide receipts to the County for such materials.

9. County shall not be liable for any charges or costs associated with any collected materials. The Contractor's compensation listed in Exhibit 4.01 of the Contract shall constitute the Contractor's full and complete compensation from the County.
10. Contractor shall report to the County all weights gathered at the sites on a monthly basis, along with tonnages sold by material type.
11. Contractor shall provide a monthly invoice to the County.
12. Siskiyou County retains liability for the "Siskiyou Recycles" bins.
13. Recyclable materials shall not need to be kept separate by site. For example, #2 plastic collected from Clinic Pharmacy bins may be commingled with #2 plastic from Seiad recycling bins.
